Gold Rush Waterpark FAQ's:

What is the temperature inside the waterpark?

We maintain the Gold Rush at 84°F

Is the Waterpark connected to my room?

The Gold Rush Waterpark is not connected to our hotel rooms right now, however the

Thoroughbred Suites are the closest accommodations, and will soon be connected by a covered walkway. For your convenience, we have a complimentary shuttle bus that provides door-to-door service from all our accommodations to the waterpark (and back again). Just dial '0' to ask for a shuttle bus, or stop at the front desk.

Do I need to bring towels?

No. We provide towels to our Gold Rush guests.

Are there lockers available?

Yes, we rent lockers for a one-day use only. Large lockers rent for \$6, and small lockers rent for \$3. We have lockers in our men's and women's locker rooms as well as outside of the locker rooms for family use. Space is limited though! Please keep in mind that luggage cannot be stored in the lockers. We recommend that you bring a small bag to place your waterpark necessities in.

What about life jackets?

Coast Guard approved life jackets can be worn in our pools and most tube slides. We do not allow any other floatation devices in the waterpark.

Is there somewhere to eat so I don't have to change?

Yes. We have the Miner's Gulp Snack Bar right at the Pool Level so that you don't have to change your swimsuit to grab a bite to eat. We have other places to eat that are located at the lobby level of the waterpark, but you must have your shoes and shirt on to go to the lobby.

Is there wireless internet available?

Yes. The entire Gold Rush Indoor Waterpark, including the lobby and restaurants, has free wireless internet access.

Can my baby get in the water?

Yes, however all babies must wear a swim diaper.

Can I buy a bathing suit there?

Yes, we have bathing suits for sale in the shops that are located in the Gold Rush lobby.

Are there height requirements for the slides?

Yes - for Thunder Canyon riders must be 42", for Miner's Plunge riders must be 48", for Stallion Falls riders must be 48" to ride without a parent and 42" to ride with a parent, for Rustler's Gulch riders must be 42".

Do I have to pay if I am not going to swim?

Yes. If you want to enter the Gold Rush Waterpark then you must pay the spectator fee. If you don't want to enter the waterpark, you can hang out in our lobby and other designated areas at no charge.

What time is check-in and check-out?

Check-in is at 4:00 pm and check-out is at 11:00 am. Guests on packages that include admission to the Gold Rush have full access to the waterpark the day of arrival and day of departure as long as the Gold Rush is open.

Can I bring a cooler into the waterpark?

No outside food or beverages will be allowed in the waterpark. This is not to be confused with food that is sold on the lobby level of the waterpark. You may certainly order food from Rustler's Roost (for example) and take it down into the waterpark to enjoy it.

Are flip-flops or aqua-socks required?

We recommend, but do not require that footwear be worn in all spaces outside the waterpark for your safety. Aqua-socks are advisable as our waterpark floor is coated in a non-slip formula that can irritate sensitive skin. Footwear is required in all of our restaurant establishments.

What is the age requirement for children to be in the waterpark by themselves?

We recommend that all children are accompanied by a parent or guardian, however, children that are 16 years of age or older may be in the park by themselves.

Can other people use the waterpark?

Yes. Public guests are welcome to buy a ticket for the use of the waterpark for the day. Day passes are limited. The only way to guarantee admission to the waterpark is to purchase an overnight package with accommodations.
